Visitor Screening Guidelines and Restrictions:

All visitors must have negative answers to both the screening questions below and wear a mask. Visitors who do not have a mask will be given one and reminded to follow hand sanitizing guidelines.

1. Have you developed a new onset cough or worsening cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, diarrhea, vomiting, headache, fever, or loss of taste or smell within the last 14 days?
2. Have you been tested for COVID-19 or ordered to quarantine in the last 14 days?

Visitor restrictions vary by department. See the list below:

“Designated visitors” are chosen by the patient and must remain the same for the length of the patient’s stay.

- **Inpatient/ACC** - Patients may have **two designated visitors** from **9 a.m. - noon** and **5 - 8 p.m.**
- **Maternity Care** – Patients may have **one designated visitor** (visitation hours not limited)
- **Physician Offices** – Patients may have **one designated visitor**
- **Imaging/Surgery** – Patients may have **one designated visitor**
- **Emergency Department** - **No Visitors Allowed** *except for pediatric and altered mental status patients, both of which may have one designated visitor.*
